

International Orientation August 28, 29 & 30, 2012



Registration for international students is on August 28 at 8:30am. The fee for the International Orientation is \$800 due on or before August 28, 2012.

International students accepted at Arroyo Pacific Academy will attend an Orientation Program on August 28, 29 and 30, 2012 which will provide an overview of the program and direct instruction. The student will be administered an

English Proficiency Examination, Mathematics and English standardized examinations to determine possible revised course placement, receive the individual Class Schedule and order books from myschoolbookstore.com.

The morning classes are from 8:30am to 11:30am for evaluation of English and Mathematics proficiency through conversation, standardized testing and writing samples. Students will be introduced to our faculty and staff, the *School Handbook*, the *International Student Handbook*, the SEVIS I-20 & Student Visa Requirements, the Agenda, the Daily Schedule, the School Calendar, and other information which will assist students in settling into life at Arroyo Pacific Academy.
