Our philosophy recognizes the value and uniqueness of each student as a person with artistic, emotional, imaginative, intellectual, physical, spiritual, and social potential. Our quarter system is unique and designed to reduce the stress experienced by many students who struggle with managing a large number of courses in a day.
